Installation

Hardware and software requirement

MGS Blackjack requires the following hardware and software to be played properly:

1. 500KB of free memory in the phone or the memory card (such as MMC).
2. MGS (Magic Games Station) Version 1.97 or later.

NOTE: MGS should be provided along with the game. If this is not the case, the latest version of MGS can be downloaded from the following websites:

Note: If you are synchronizing the game from your PC, be sure to delete the SMS message in the phone containing the game files after installation. The installation files occupy memory and are not needed after installation.

Install the game

If you have received **MGS Blackjack** on a compact disc provided by your phone provider or downloaded the game from the internet, then follow the installation instructions below. If the full version game is provided to you e.g. on your MMC, then you may go directly to the "Playing MGS Blackjack" section.





STEP ONE: Transfer the MGS and game files (*.sis files) from the PC to your phone via IrDA or Bluetooth.

STEP TWO: In your Messages/Inbox, open the *.sis files to launch the installer. Follow the instructions that are automatically prompted during the installation. Be sure to install all the files in the same location.

STEP THREE: Once the installation is successfully completed, you will see a large red **M** symbol (for MGS) on your desktop. Launching it will bring you to the MGS game list menu. **MGS Blackjack** can be launched from there.

Note: Memory card e.g. MMC installation is supported, but MGS and the game should be installed in the same driver/location.

How to register and play the full game

MGS Blackjack is a shareware and can be downloaded as a free playable demo. The demo mode is limited to only one round every time, after that it'll go to the register UI. The demo version of the game is provided free so you can see and try the game before making a purchase. The full version of the game will feature all game features, unlimited play time and multiplayer games.

Please follow these instructions to purchase the game:

1. Purchase the game from www.nmprod.com or the websites mentioned previously (Credit card is required).
2. On the purchasing form, fill in the IMEI code of your phone. (The IMEI code is the hardware identification code of your phone and is used to generate the unlock code for **MGS Blackjack**. (You can usually obtain the IMEI code of your phone by typing ***#06#** on your phone in dial mode. In **MGS Blackjack**, the IMEI automatically appears in the REGISTER interface.)
3. Please provide a valid e-mail address. The registration key will be sent to this address within 24 business hours.
4. In the game, select OPTIONS > REGISTER to go to the registration user interface. You can enter the registration code here.

Important: Please keep your registration code in a safe place. If you lose the registration code and need a reinstallation of the game, please contact Noumena customer support at support@nmprod.com.

Playing *MGS Blackjack*

Introduction

Blackjack is one of the most popular casino games in the world. In this game, a player wins if the sum of his cards is more than the dealer without going over 21. Exceeding 21 is called a “bust”. If the player and dealer tie, the bet is a “push”.

Start the game

Once you have launched MGS from your desktop, you will go to a game list and see the following icon:



Highlight this and press the navigation pad or joystick down to launch the game.

After the starting screen, you will see the Main User Interface (UI). Use the navigation pad or joystick to choose menu items. Then use the joystick to select or confirm your selection.

- To start a Single Player game

Go to the **Main Menu** UI > select **Single Player**

- To start a Two-player game using two handsets via Bluetooth (See UI above)

Go to the **Main Menu** UI > select **Bluetooth Host** or **Bluetooth Join**

Note: *If you want to host a Bluetooth game, please remember to enable the Bluetooth connection before starting MGS.*

After a Bluetooth connection is made, the game will automatically start. The hosting player will start as the dealer, followed by the other player in alternating turns.

When the game is over, if a player wants to play again, he can select **NEW**. When all players have selected **NEW**, a new game will start.

During a Bluetooth game, players can communicate with each other via Voice Chat.

Game play

Setting the bet amount:

Before the start of each hand, each player can set his/her bet in the betting box at the bottom right of the screen (See UI below). Use the joystick or navigation pad to select and set the bet amount. The maximum initial bet per hand is \$250. Once the bet amount is set, it will remain the same for each hand unless changed before the start of the next hand.

Two-player game

Playing a hand:

Once all the bets are placed, select **DEAL** by pushing the Left Soft Key. Two cards will then be dealt to each player. Your two cards will face up while the other players will show one card up and one card down. The other players will see your cards as one card up and one card down. Each player will then play his/her hand in sequence ending with the dealer.

Each player's hand is played against the dealer's hand only. A player wins if the sum of his cards is more than the dealer without going over 21 (bust). The best possible hand is known as a Blackjack (twenty-one in the first two cards). This hand consists of an Ace and a ten-valued card (10, Jack, Queen, King).

The player has several choices after receiving the first two cards:

- **HIT** – take one more card to add-up to a better hand.
- **STAND** – stop taking more cards.
- **DOUBLE** – take only ONE more card and double the initial bet amount.
- **SPLIT** – if the first two cards are equal in value, they may be played in two separate hands.
- **INSURANCE** – this comes into play when the dealer's card facing up is an Ace. If a player wants insurance, half of the original bet is placed as the insurance amount. If the dealer then shows Blackjack, the player only loses the insurance amount.

The dealer has limited choices:

- The dealer must hit until he reaches a score of 17 or more.

Use the joystick or navigation pad to select and confirm your choice. A player must select a choice e.g. Stand, Hit, Double, etc. within the time indicated by the countdown timer at the top left of the screen. When time expires, the game will automatically make a move.

Scoring:

Cards of rank 2 through 10 are scored according to their face value. All face cards (Jack, Queen, King) are 10 points. Aces are semi-wild and can be worth either 1 or 11 points.

Rules:

- Bust – score over 21 is a bust.
- Push – when a player and the dealer have the same score.
- Five cards – any five-card hand that has not busted. It's only smaller than Blackjack.
- No Ace split – a pair of Aces are not allowed to be split.
- No re-split – a pair can only be split once in a hand.
- No Ace double – a player is not allowed to double if he has an Ace.
- Double after split – a double is allowed after a split.
- No Blackjack after split - if a player gets a Blackjack after a split, the hand total is considered a 21, but not a Blackjack.
- Allow double only if the hand's total is larger than 9 after receiving the first two cards.
- A player is not allowed to split and double after Insurance.

Game settings

You can change the game settings by selecting **OPTIONS** in the game's Main UI. The Options UI will allow you to turn Audio on/off, turn Voice chat on/off and Register the game. Use the joystick to highlight the item you want to select. Then press the joystick to change the selection. Once done, select **BACK** (Right Soft Key) to save the setting and return to the previous UI.
